Student Travel Grant Opportunity

Sponsored by E-Next

The IEEE Infocom 2005 organizing committee is pleased to announce the availability of Student Travel Grants, sponsored by E-Next. Applications are invited from qualified people whose institution is an E-Next member. Around ten awards are expected.

Eligibility

The following groups are eligible to apply for this grant:

1. Ph.D student with paper (author or co-author)
2. Researcher with invited presentation
3. Ph.D student (just attending)
4. Researcher with paper
5. Program Committee member
6. Others

Grant Benefits

The grant consists of a lump sum of 1000 Euros.

Notes:

The student's institution will receive the grant amount after the conference is over. A copy of the Infocom 2005 registration receipt should be sent to kukielka@it.uc3m.es.

How to apply

An application for a travel award will consist of:

1. A letter from the student, including paper title if paper has been accepted for Infocom 2005,
2. The student's vita, and
3. A supporting letter from the student's graduate advisor.

The letter from the student should include:

1. A brief summary of research interests and accomplishments to date,
2. A description of areas reflected in the Infocom 2005 program that would impact the student's research, and
3. A statement about why the conference attendance is important to the student.
4. Specifying that the application is for an E-Next travel grant.

The advisor's recommendation letter to the committee should include:

1. Confirmation that the student is a bona-fide Ph.D. or M.S. candidate in good standing,
2. The suitability of the Infocom 2005 program material to the student's research area,
3. Ways this particular student would benefit from attendance at the conference, and
4. The strengths and potential contributions of the student.

Where to Send

1. Students should send their application materials as a single-PDF file by email to znati@cs.pitt.edu by **January 31, 2005**.
2. Advisors should send their recommendation letters, preferably by email, to the same address above by **January 31, 2005**.
